NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MAKE CORK CITY ROAD TRAFFIC (SPECIAL SPEED LIMIT) BYE-LAWS, 2016

Take notice that Cork City Council proposes to make the above-entitled Bye-Laws in respect of public roads within the City of Cork, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004. The purpose of the proposed Bye-Laws is to introduce special speed limit of 30kph in residential areas at Silverheights Mayfield, Cardinal Way Bishopstown, Monastery Hill Blarney Street and The Glen.

A copy of the draft Cork City Road Traffic (Special Speed Limit) Bye-Laws, 2016 will be available for public inspection during the period of Friday, 22nd July 2016 to Monday, 22nd August 2016 between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm at the Reception Desk, City Hall, Anglesea Street, Cork.
