TO OWNERS OF HACKNEY CARRIAGES.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Hackney Carriage Committee (acting with the authority of the Council) has made the following Regulations, which are to be strictly observed by all persons seeking Licenses for Hackney Carriages, whether same have been previously licensed or not.

1. Every applicant for a license shall in the first instance pay the license fee to the Treasurer, at his Office, City Courthouse, who shall thereupon supply him with a printed form of requisition, as prescribed by the Bye-laws, certifying on the back of such form that the license fee has been paid.

2. The applicant shall then duly fill up and subscribe such requisition, and his signature shall be witnessed by some officer of the Corporation.

3. The Hackney Carriage (with horse and harness) to ply which such license is required, shall then (at a time and place to be appointed by the Committee) be submitted for inspection by two Members of the Committee, with the City Engineer, to whom shall be produced the requisition duly perfected, as above, and who shall, in case such carriage, horse and harness are, in their opinion, in compliance with Bye-law No. 11, certify on the back of such requisition that same have passed inspection, and shall at the same time affix an indelible mark to the car, for its future identification.

4. That when the certificate of inspection shall have been endorsed upon the requisition, same shall be deposited with the Secretary of Committees, and by him submitted to next meeting of the Hackney Carriage Committee, for their decision as to whether such license shall be granted or not.

5. That no requisition for a license, which is not in strict compliance with the foregoing conditions, shall be brought before the Committee; and no license shall be granted in the absence of such requisition.

6. That in case the Committee grant such license, their order, specifying the number to be borne by such carriage, shall be endorsed upon the requisition, and signed by the Chairman, and the document shall then be returned to the applicant, who shall, thereupon, have the prescribed No. painted thereon in strict conformity with Bye-law No. 18, with the addition that such No. shall be painted *black on a white ground*.

7. That in allotting the Nos. to the several cars, the Order of 9th of January last be adhered to, the numbers being allotted in consecutive order, as applied for, but the odd numbers only to be borne by inside, and the even numbers by outside cars.

8. That as soon as the No. shall have been affixed to the car in accordance with these instructions—which fact shall be certified by the Inspector of Hackney Carriages—and within one week after the order of the Committee, the applicant shall exchange the requisition, at the Town Clerk's Office, for the License prescribed by the Bye-laws.

9. That such license shall, in future, be in force for one year, commencing the 1st day of July in the year of issue, and no longer.

10. That in the event of the Committee refusing to grant a license, such refusal shall be endorsed on the requisition, and signed by the Chairman; and on production of the requisition, so endorsed, to the Treasurer, he shall return the licence fee to the applicant, retaining the requisition as his voucher for such refund.

11. That whenever the proprietor of a licensed car shall dispose of his interest in same to another person, the license shall thereupon be surrendered and cancelled, and the new proprietor shall not be at liberty to ply the car for hire until a new license shall have been granted by the Committee, on requisition duly made, and inspection passed, as in the case of a car not previously licensed; the old license to be handed in with the requisition to the Secretary of Committees.
