3. **Please note that Cork City Council is obliged to provide the name, address and PPS No for all licence holders to the Minister for Social Welfare and the Revenue Commissioners:** Section 4(11) of the Casual Trading Act, 1995, provides that the local authority concerned shall notify the Minister for Social Welfare of the name and address of a person to whom a casual trading licence was granted and the conditions of the licence. Section 4(2A) of the Casual Trading Act, 1995 (inserted by Section 141 of the Finance Act, 1996(No.9 of 1996) provides that the local authority concerned shall notify the Revenue Commissioners of the name, address and tax reference number of a person to whom a casual trading licence was granted and the conditions of the licence. Section 13 of the Casual Trading Act, 1995 also provides that a local authority may establish and maintain the Register of Casual Trading Licences on computer. In such circumstances, personal data kept in the register is subject to the requirements of the Data Protection Act, 1988(No. 25 of 1988) including an individuals right of access to and verification of data, where appropriate.
4. **Licence holders are to obey all lawful requests of an Authorised Officer of Cork City Council, or a member of the Garda Síochána.**
