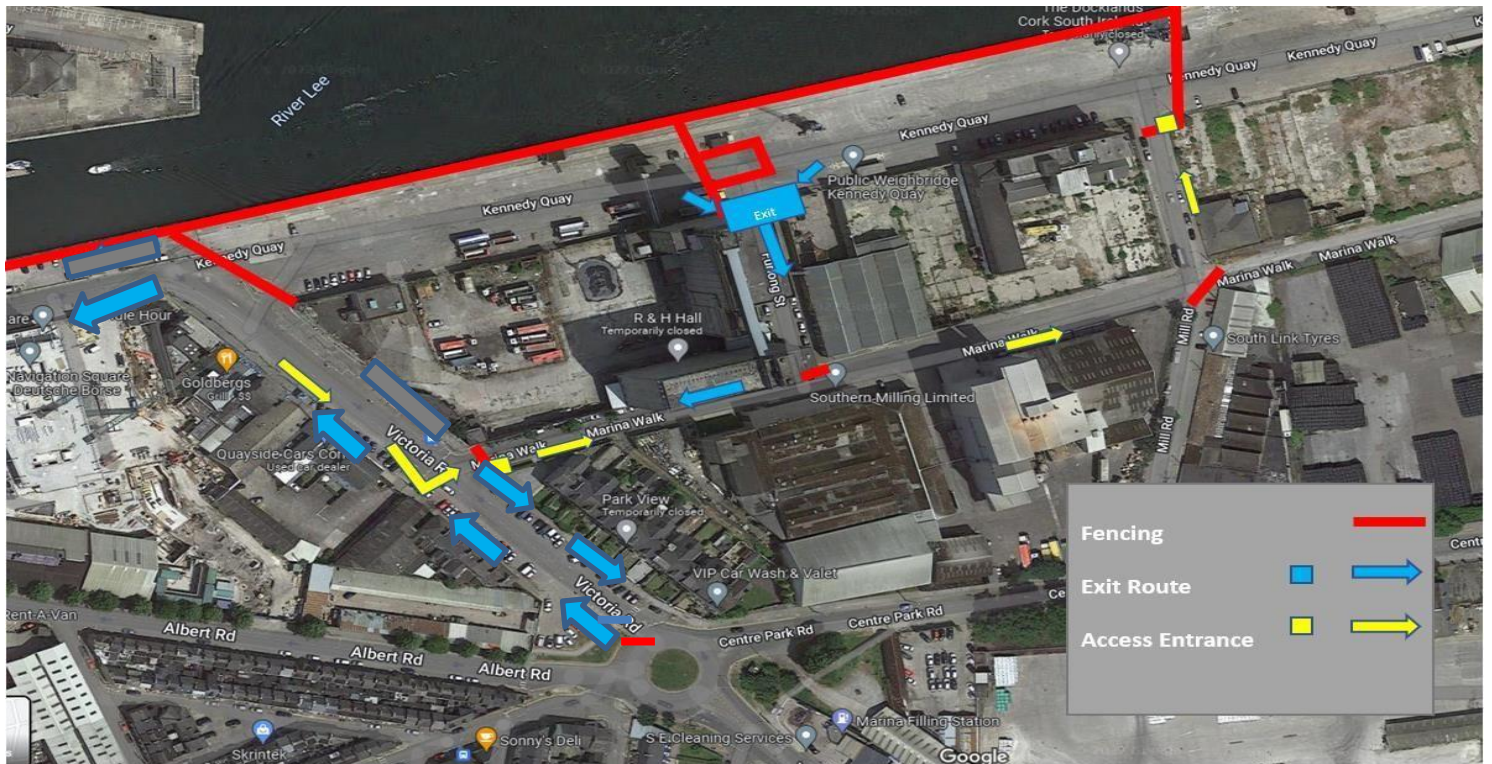

<b>REASON FOR PEDESTERIAN MANAGEMENT</b>	
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The Cork LGBT & Pride Festival are proposing to hold a Cork LGBT Pride after show Party on the 06th of August 2023.

This plan will describe the various arrangement for the Cork LGBT Pride After Show Party to ensure it's safe and successful execution. It has been prepared in accordance with the relevant Codes of Practice and includes arrangements for health and safety management, risk assessments & emergency planning. It outlines the roles and responsibilities of the organisers and their commitment to providing an event where the health, safety, and welfare of the public and the staff are paramount.

## **PEDESTERIAN MANAGEMENT PLAN OVERVIEW**



Access to Cork LGBT Pride After Show Party will be via Victoria Road , turn down onto Marina Walk where the pedestrians will be routed into Kennedy Quay via the Mill road, all access and egress routes will be manned , barred and clearly signposted to ensure no unwanted access . No traffic will be allowed along Marina Walk for the duration of the After show Party.

The Quay side on Kennedy Quay will be fully barred off from the public, Barriers erected at the entrance to Kennedy Quay will be used for the setup and removal of heavy equipment , marquees and stands. In the event of crowding there will be an allocated holding area with Kennedy Quay to control the exit of people once the Cork LGBT Pride After Show Party is finished. Egress from the Aftershow Party will be via Furlong St back onto the Marina Walk, when the partygoers reach Victoria road they will be directed left down the footpath to the Centre Park Road Roundabout, where they will cross on the pedestrian crossing and return to the city centre via either Albert Rd or the western footpath of Victoria Road.

## EVENT DETAILS

### Event Description

The festival is a non-for-profit celebration of social diversity and inclusiveness and is designed to create a positive and enjoyable experience for the participants and the general public that are invited to take part in all the events of the festival, this event will be held on the 06<sup>th</sup> of August 2023 within Kennedy Quay. Patrons will arrive and park by foot at the pre-marked out pedestrian route which will be fully sign posted and controlled at all times prior to and after the Cork LGBT Pride After show event.

There will be stage with various artists performing on it, these will be various acts (Pop, DJ and Drag Queens).

Food and drink will be served throughout the duration of the after-show event party, all safety, hygiene and clean up controls (Temporary bins / cleaners will be in-place to ensure no rubbish is left).

No Alcohol will be served

Toilet blocks will be supplied to cater for the proposed crowd

Build / Break, the event build will start at 6am on the 06 August and will be derigged immediately after the site is cleared of all patrons.

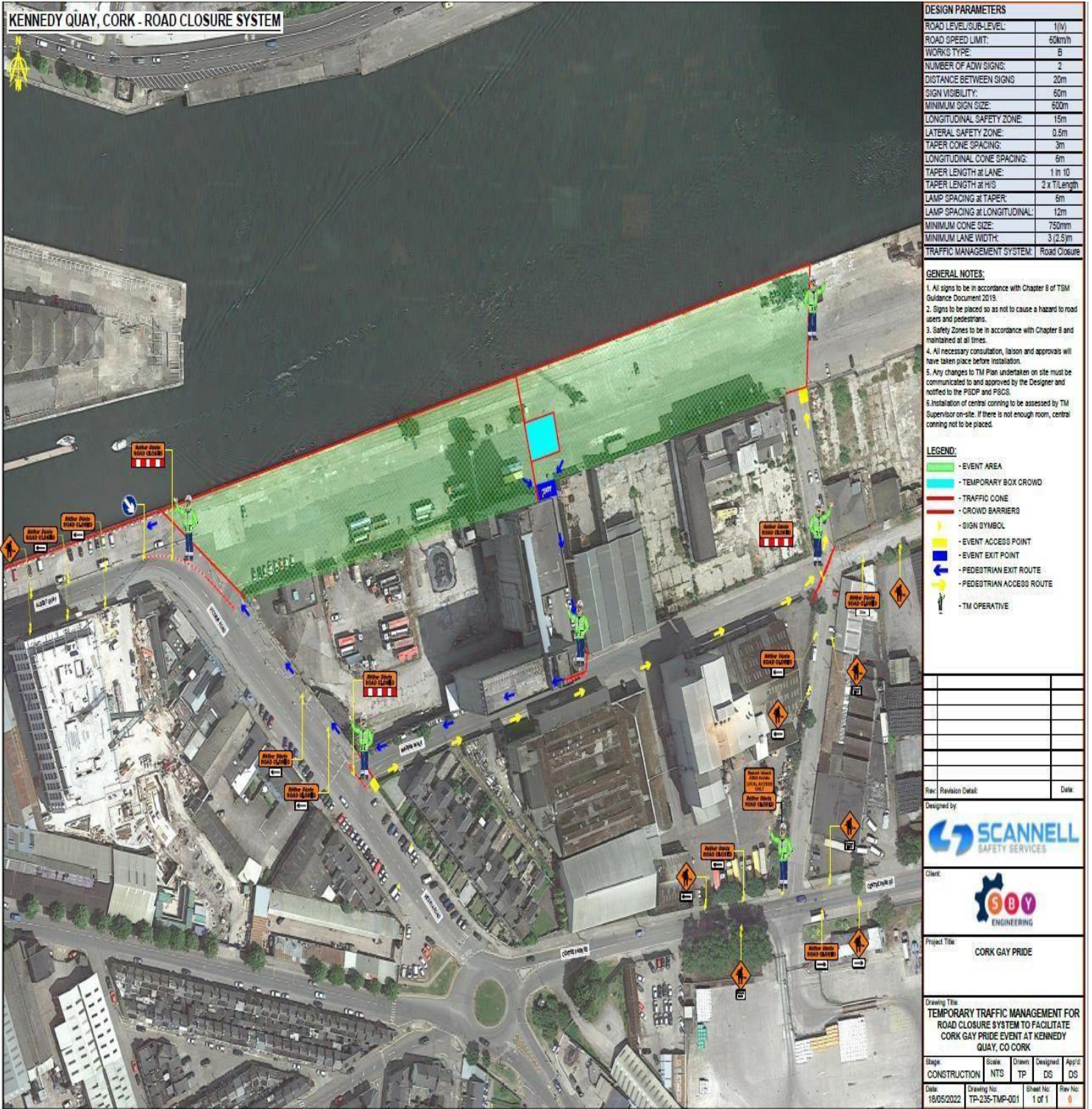

Entertainment will start at : 3pm









