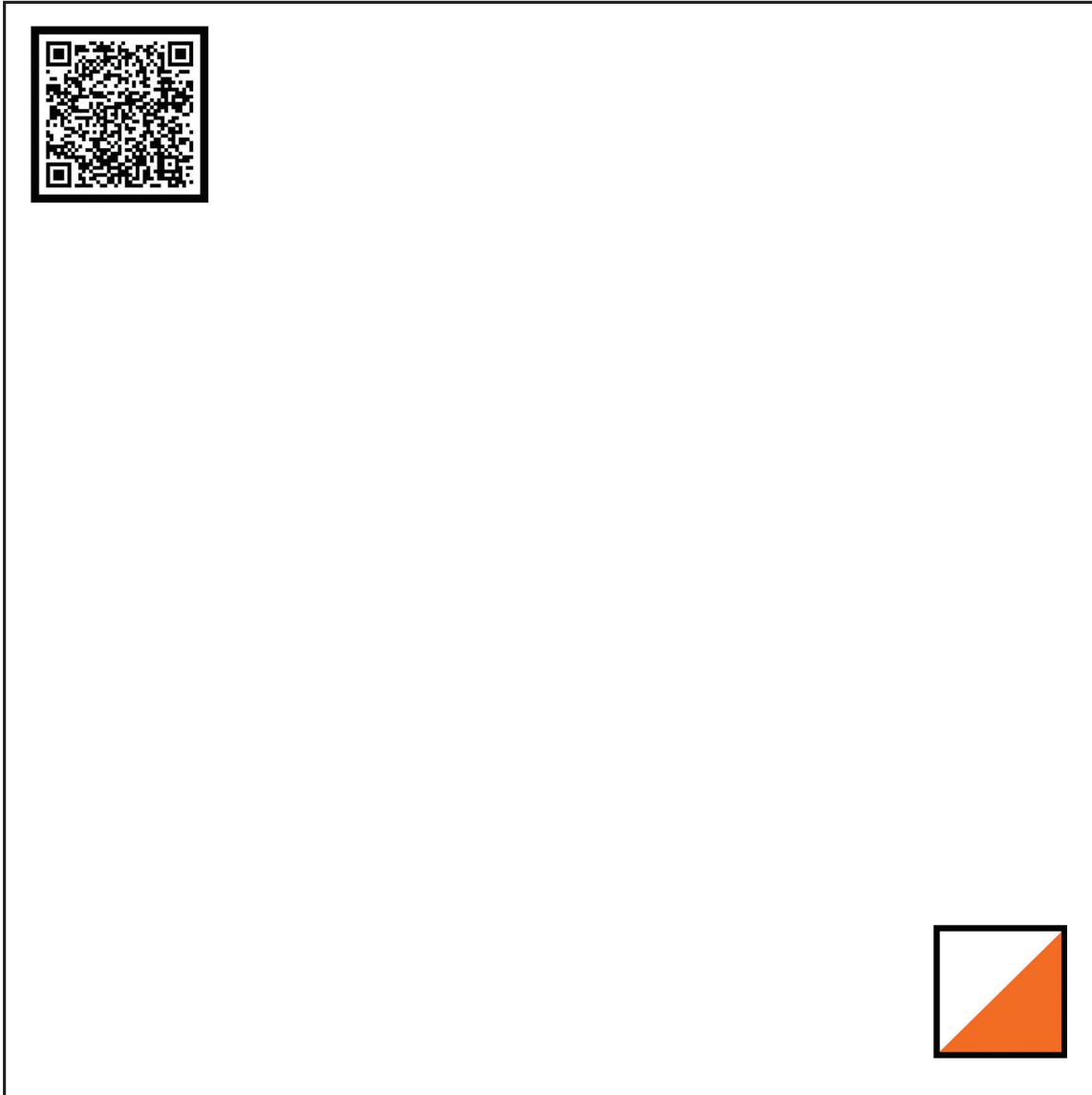
- Submitted artwork must be your own original work. The artwork must be in black and white (line-art).

- Images will be credited (eg. Artwork: Joe Blogs, Cork).
- You warrant to us that all contributions are lawful and do not infringe any rights of any third party and that you will indemnify us in respect of any breach of that warranty.
- No liability accepted for any content submitted by third parties. We reserve the right to share your identity with any third party who is claiming that any image submitted by you violates copyright laws.
- You will not submit images that are offensive, abusive, indecent, defamatory, obscene.

# Guidelines for creating your image:

## Hints and Tips to create artwork suitable for the orienteering tiles:

Artwork will be printed on tiles so black and white images with loads of contrast and not too much shading will reproduce best (hint: Pen and Ink. black markers or black crayon / chunky charcoal are good mediums).

The orienteering route is all about Cork's architectural heritage. Visit our 8 locations (In the Marsh and South Parish or found on <https://www.corkcity.ie/orienteering/>). At your chosen location, have a look around, look up at the eaves of buildings and the street furniture around you to see if you can spot interesting details. For example; roofs, railings, windows, house fronts, doors, decorative details and natural heritage (particularly along the river at the bridge stops).
