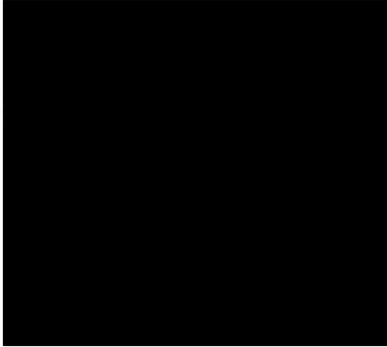

In this report 'the Act' means the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and 'the Regulations' means the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), unless otherwise indicated.

1. REQUIREMENTS FOR A SECTION 5 DECLARATION

Section 5(1) of the Planning and Development Act 2000 as amended states,

5.—(1) If any question arises as to what, in any particular case, is or is not development or is or is not exempted development within the meaning of this Act, any person may, on payment of the prescribed fee, request in writing from the relevant planning authority a declaration on that question, and that person shall provide to the planning authority any information necessary to enable the authority to make its decision on the matter.

The requirements for making a section 5 declaration are set out in the Act.

2. THE QUESTION BEFORE THE PLANNING AUTHORITY

As per Q2 of the application form:

Whether the proposed rooftop installation of 6no. Telecommunications antennae, remote radio units (RRU), GPS, support poles, ballast mounts, ladder hooks, cable trays and equipment cabinet and all ancillary site works to provide high-speed wireless data and broadband services at leisureworld, Knockfree Avenue, Churchfield, Cork is Development and if so is it or is it not Exempted Development?

3. SITE DESCRIPTION

The S5 application concerns Leisureworld, Knockfree Avenue, Churchfield, Cork is Development and if so is it or is it not Exempted Development?

4. PLANNING HISTORY

No planning history shown on planning enquiry.

5. STATUTORY PROVISIONS

5.1 The Act

Section 2 (1) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, defines a statutory undertaker as, in this context: “a person, for the time being, authorised by or under any enactment or instrument under an enactment to - ... (b) provide, or carry out works for the provision of, gas, electricity or telecommunications services,”

Section 3 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, defines development as follows:

In this Act, “development” means, except where the context otherwise requires, the carrying out of any works on, in, over or under land or the making of any material change in the use of any structures or other land. Works are defined in that section as: “works” includes any act or operation of construction, excavation, demolition, extension, alteration, repair or renewal and, in relation to a protected structure or proposed protected structure, includes any act or operation involving the application or removal of plaster, paint, wallpaper, tiles or other material to or from the surfaces of the interior or exterior of a structure.

Section 4 states:

(2) (a) The Minister may by regulations provide for any class of development to be exempted development for the purposes of this Act where he or she is of the opinion that— (i) by reason of the size, nature or limited effect on its surroundings, of development belonging to that class, the carrying out of such development would not offend against principles of proper planning and sustainable development,

or

(ii) the development is authorised, or is required to be authorised, by or under any enactment (whether the authorisation takes the form of the grant of a licence, consent, approval or any other type of authorisation) where the enactment concerned requires there to be consultation (howsoever described) with members of the public in relation to the proposed development prior to the granting of the authorisation (howsoever described).

(b) Regulations under paragraph (a) may be subject to conditions and be of general application or apply to such area or place as may be specified in the regulations.

(c) Regulations under this subsection may, in particular and without prejudice to the generality of paragraph (a), provide, in the case of structures or other land used for a purpose of any specified class, for the use thereof for any other purpose being exempted development for the purposes of this Act.

Section 177U (9) concerns the need to screen referrals for Appropriate Assessment issues: (9) In deciding upon F787[a declaration or a referral under section 5] of this Act a planning authority or the Board, as the case may be, shall where appropriate, conduct a screening for appropriate assessment in accordance with the provisions of this section.]

The Planning and Development Regulations, 2001 as amended.

A number of Articles are relevant to the referral:

Article 5 (2) In Schedule 2,

unless the context otherwise requires, any reference to the height of a structure, plant or machinery shall be construed as a reference to its height when measured from ground level, and for that purpose “ground level” means the level of the ground immediately adjacent to the structure, plant or machinery or, where the level of the ground where it is situated or is to be situated is not uniform, the level of the lowest part of the ground adjacent to it.

Article 6. (1)

Subject to article 9, development of a class specified in column 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 2 shall be exempted development for the purposes of the Act, provided that such development complies with the conditions and limitations specified in column 2 of the said Part 1 opposite the mention of that class in the said column

Article 9 (1) Development to which article 6 relates shall not be exempted development for the purposes of the Act— (a) if the carrying out of such development would— (i) contravene a condition attached to a permission under the Act or be inconsistent with any use specified in a permission under the Act,

The section below will consider the Classes of Exempted Development and their limitations.

CLASS 31 The carrying out by a statutory undertaker authorised to provide a Telecommunications service of development consisting of the provision of—

(f) cabinets forming part of a telecommunications system –

Limitation – The volume above the ground-level of any such cabinet shall not exceed 2 cubic metres measured externally.

(k) antennae, including small cell antennae, attached to the following existing structures—

(i) public or commercial buildings (other than education facilities, childcare facilities or hospitals) by way of attachment to roofs, facades, chimneys, chimney pots or vent pipes;

Limitation

1. The antenna shall be attached directly to the structure (other than a structure with a flat roof) and not by way of a supporting fixture.

2. In the case of a structure with a flat roof, a supporting fixture may be used provided that– (a) the fixture does not exceed the height of any existing parapet or railing on the roof by more than 3 metres, and (b) access to the roof is not available to any person other than a person authorised by the statutory undertaker.

3. Where an antenna is attached to the façade of a building or the exterior of a chimney or vent, the colour of the antenna shall match and blend with the colour of such façade, chimney or vent pipe.

4. Where the antenna is hidden inside a chimney pot the existing chimney pot may be replaced by a chimney pot in a suitable material which shall be the same colour, size and shape as the replaced pot, and the antenna shall not protrude beyond the top of the chimney pot.

5. The planning authority in whose functional area the structure on which the antennae will be attached is situated shall be notified by the statutory undertaker in writing of the proposed location of any such structure at least 4 weeks before such attachment.

6. The field strength of any such antenna shall not result in the field strength of the non-ionising radiation emission from the radio installations on the site exceeding the limits specified by the Commission for Communications Regulation.

ASSESSMENT

Section 5 declarations ascertain what is and is not development and if that development is exempted development or not. Therefore, the planning merits of the case or the impacts of exempted development is not a consideration in the assessment.

The question to be considered is whether the erection of the following, is or is not development and is or is not exempted development:

The proposed rooftop installation of 6no. Telecommunications antennae, remote radio units (RRU), GPS, support poles, ballast mounts, ladder hooks, cable trays and equipment cabinet and all ancillary site works to provide high-speed wireless data and broadband services at Leisureworld, Knockfree Avenue, Churchfield, Cork is Development and if so is it or is it not Exempted Development?

The erection of the telecommunications infrastructure involves works. Therefore, the erection of the telecommunications infrastructure is development.

In relation to whether the development is exempted development, the restrictions on exemption under Article 9 must be considered. There does not appear to be a condition restricting the use of the roof of the Churchfield Leisure Centre.

Three (Hutchinson) Limited are statutory undertakers for the purposes of the Planning and Development Act. The company is a licenced suppliers of telecommunications services.

We, Entrust Limited (T/A Entrust Planning & Environmental) on behalf of our client Three Ireland (Hutchinson) Limited are making this submission to seek a Declaration in accordance with Section 5 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended), to determine if the proposed installation of 6 no. telecommunications antennae, remote radio units (RRU's), GPS, support poles, ballast mounts, ladders, cable tray, access platform and equipment cabinet and all ancillary site works, to provide high-speed wireless data and broadband services at Leisure World Churchfield, Knockfree Avenue, Churchfield, Co. Cork constitutes 'exempted development'.

Proposal

Three Ireland (Hutchinson) Limited proposes to install electronic communications apparatus / development consisting of 6 no. telecommunications antennae, remote radio units (RRU's), GPS, support poles and outdoor equipment cabinet and all ancillary site works on the roof of Leisure World Churchfield, Knockfree Avenue, Churchfield, Co. Cork (ITM X: 566342 Y: 572985).

Description of Development

- Installation of 6 no. telecommunication antennae on the rooftop of Leisure World Churchfield.
- An equipment cabinet not measuring more than 2 cubic metres when measured externally
- Ancillary development thereto which includes all RRU's, GPS, ballast mounts, cable tray, ladders, access platform and support poles.

Planning History

Following a search on ePlan, October 2025, no relevant telecommunications planning history was discovered with the proposed site. Detailed below are previous planning applications in the environs of the site.

Site and Planning Designations

The proposed development consists of a rooftop structure to be installed on Leisure World in Churchfield Co. Cork, approximately 1.4 kilometres northwest of Cork City centre. The site is zoned as per the Cork City Development Plan 2022-2028 under Zoning Objective 16, Sports Grounds and Facilities, which aims *"to protect, retain and enhance the range and quality of sports facilities and grounds"*. The dominant zoning designation enclosing the site is Zoning Objective O1 Sustainable, Residential Neighbourhoods, which is evidenced by residential estates to the west, north and east. The nearest residential dwelling is approximately 70 m to the west, with rows of terraced housing estates in the environs of the site location. Community facilities including a parochial hall, sports complex, a pre-school and a playground are present in the vicinity of the site, likewise recreational facilities comprising a GAA club and music school.

The site is accessed via the public road, namely, the L-5055 Knockfree Avenue south of the site, to a public entrance to the Leisure World complex.

The proposal is to install telecommunications on the roof of an existing leisure centre complex in Churchfield, Co. Cork in line with Schedule 2 of the Planning and Development Regulations (as amended). The Cork City Development Plan 2022–2028 supports the provision of telecommunications infrastructure identifying it as a crucial infrastructure for Cork City in terms of international connectivity and economic growth. The siting of the structure aligns with the Telecommunications Antennae and Support Structures Guidelines for Planning Authorities (1996), which encourages the use of tall buildings in hosting telecommunications infrastructure in urban and suburban areas. The use of existing buildings particularly in developed areas, avoids the proliferation of new masts by providing an appropriate line of sight to ‘see’ above the existing built form.

Although the leisure centre is a prominent feature of the local community and landscape, the proposed development will be minor in comparison. The telecommunications equipment will be low profile and furnished in a colour that assimilates with the existing building and the colour of the typical Irish skyline. These measures will aid in integrating the proposal into the rooftop setting. From the perspective of the nearby receptors, development will appear as part of the leisure centre rooftop and will not materially alter the surrounding landscape. The character of the existing leisure centre does not materially change with the facilitation of the proposal. The improved coverage will benefit sensitive receptors in the local area through the provision of high-speed, reliable telecommunications services.

The installation will improve network coverage in the area, providing a reliable mobile service for households, schools, businesses and residents of the community. All works to be carried out are confined to the rooftop of the leisure centre, with consideration of nearby properties in terms of noise emissions and shadowing. The proposal is in

compliance with relevant public safety standards, including the International Commission on Non - Ionizing Radiation Protection (ICNIRP) guidelines.

The site is outside of any heritage or ecologically sensitive areas with the closest being SMR CO074-017001 approximately 460 m northwest of the site. The closest NIAH building is 500 m southwest, namely, NIAH 20862020 Church of the Ascension Roman Catholic Church. Given the separation distances and existing built form, it is considered that the proposal will not significantly affect these sites during either construction or operation.

Article 9 (1)(a)(vi) restrictions on exemptions of the Regulations states:

“Development to which article 6 relates shall not be exempted development for the purposes of the Act–

(vi) interfere with the character of a landscape, or a view or prospect of special amenity value or special interest, the preservation of which is an objective of a development plan for the area in which the development is proposed or, pending the variation of a development plan or the making of a new development plan, in the draft variation of the development plan or the draft development plan,”

There are no visual sensitivities associated with the proposed site thus it is considered the proposed development will not seriously injure or interfere with the visual amenity of the surrounding landscape. The site is comprehensively screened with the presence of mature trees around the perimeter of the leisure centre complex. In addition, Cork City is renowned for its topographical make up and steep slopes, which aids with mitigating visual concerns regarding the proposed development.

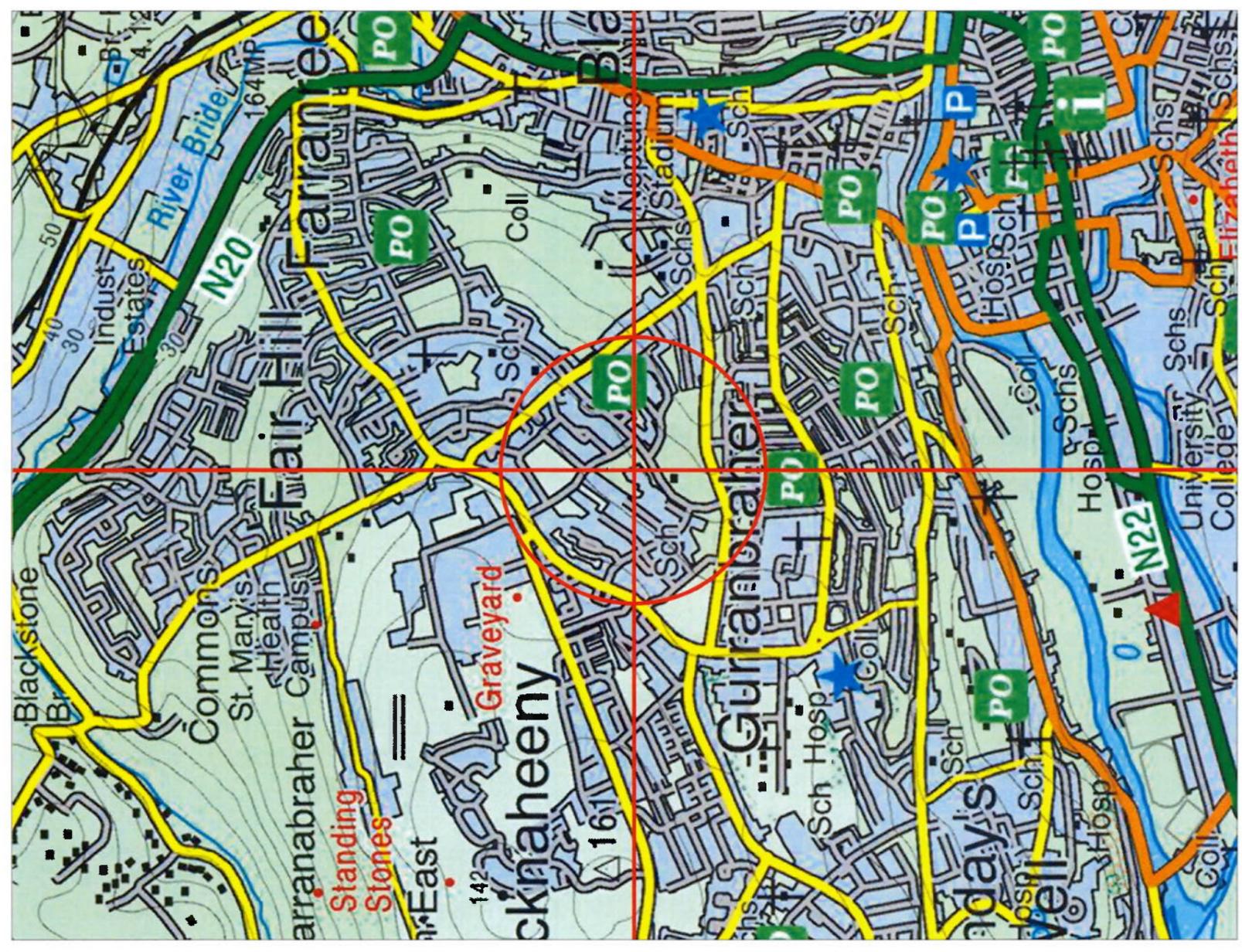


Fig.1 - Elevation



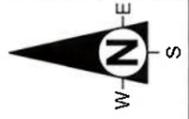
Fig.2 - Location of H3GI Equipment Container

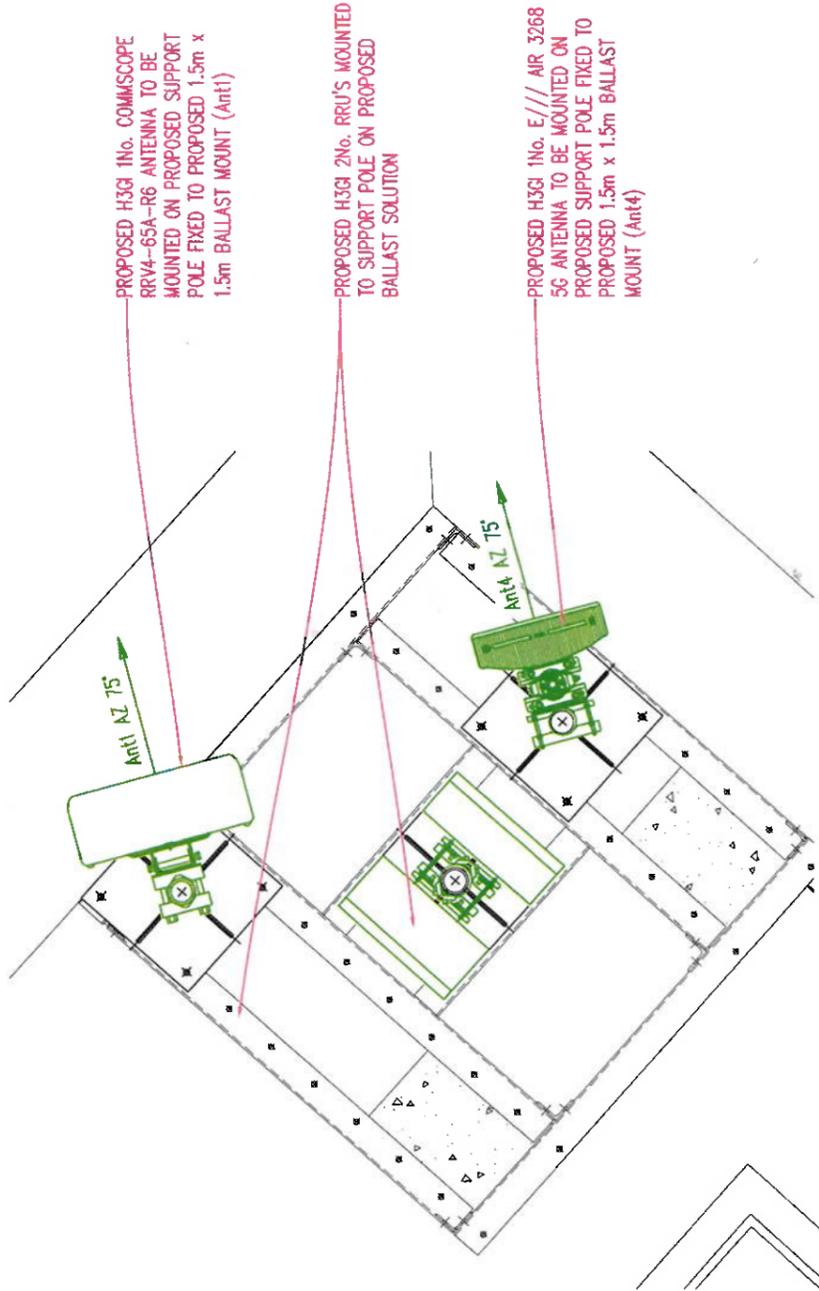

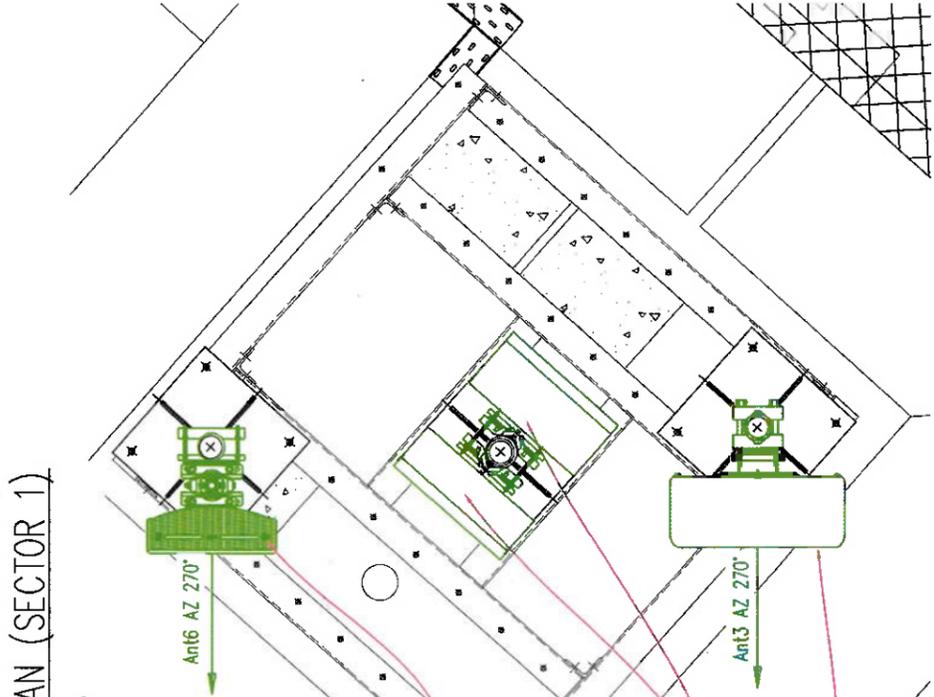
ANTENNA LAYOUT PLAN (SECTOR 1)

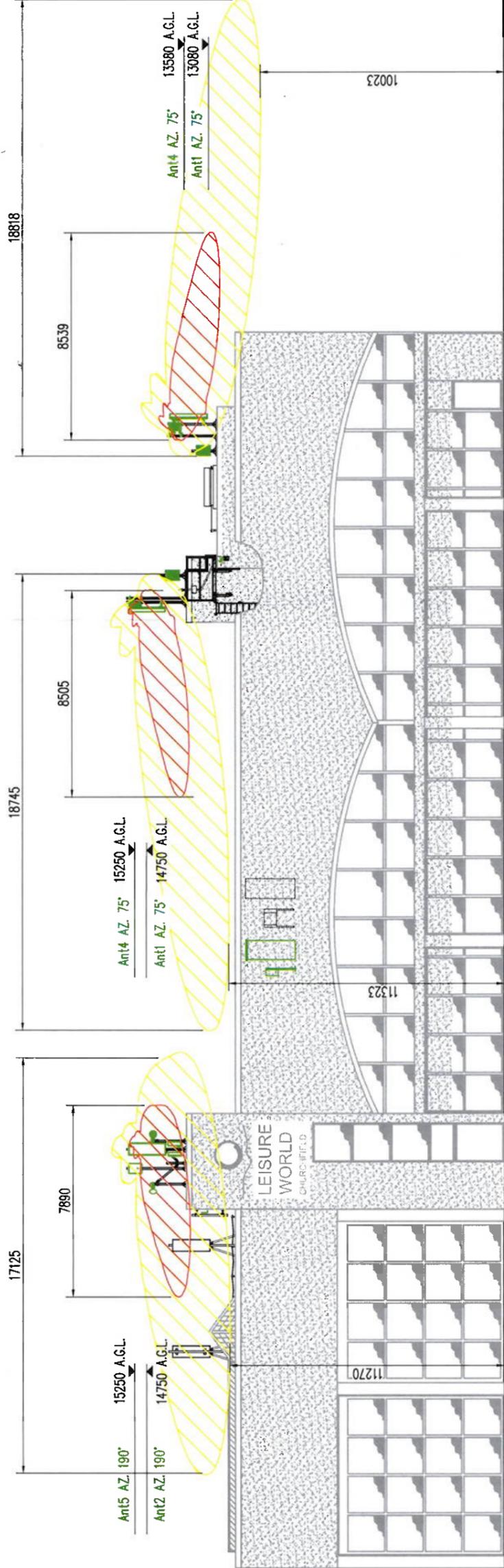
