1. Welcome

2. Minutes

3. For information:

a. Cork City Council Community Response Team

Denis Barrett: response forum met on the 20th of January, and the Forum is to remain in place with the focus on vulnerable people.

b. Funding Streams

Kieran O'Connell: gave a breakdown of the different funding streams, and this information was also previously sent by email to the LCDC.

i. Community Enhancement Programme 2021

The budget was €153,703. Total ask was €339,399.24 from 59 applications.

€60,000 allocated to 10 RAPID applicants and the remaining €93,703 allocated to 40 applicants.

ii. Healthy Ireland Fund Update

iii. Social Enterprise Grant 2021

Total allocated was €37,129 with a total ask of €84,406.32 from 19 applications.

€37,129 allocated to 12 applicants.

iv. LGBTI+ Dormant Accounts

Full tranche 1 and 2 paid to all groups awarded. Each of the four awardees: LINC, The Sexual Health Centre, The Gay Project, and Cork LGBT Pride Festival have all submitted their Grant Work Plans to deliver on their project proposals.

v. Communities Activities Fund

The '*LCDC Community Enhancement Programme's Community Activities Fund 2022 in Partnership with the Cork City Council's Community Development Grants 2022*' is now open for applications. **Closing date 21st February 2022 at 5pm.**

c. Public Participation Network Report

Kieran O'Connell: St Josephs in Mayfield to host PPN worker. SLA has been signed off. Employment of new resource worker being advertised and interviews by 2nd of March.

ClIr Fergal Dennehy: this news is very welcome and community groups coming together. Input by PPN is very important to this group.

Kieran O'Connell: Jamie Moore's work on supporting the PPN has been brilliant to get to this stage of development.

Catherine Kennedy: would appreciate a quick email about this as we didn't realise an appointment will be done soon.

d. SICAP Reviews and Reports

Kieran O'Connell: gave a presentation on the Annual Performance Review and all targets where exceeded. Statement of priorities for 2022 will be long term unemployed and older people in isolation.

SICAP Plan for 2022 approval was discussed and approved - On the proposal of ClIr Kelleher, seconded by Catherine Kennedy.

4. Strategic Items:

a. Sláintecare Healthy Communities

Kieran O'Connell: explained that Tanya O'Sullivan is starting on The 7th of February 2022 to take up the new role of Sláintecare Development Worker. The local Implementation team is to meet soon.

Gabriel O'Keeffe: HSE side of the partnership is now developed. Food and Nutrition Programmes will be allocated funding.

b. LECP Presentation


Currently, the LCDC have a year to put the LECP together (6 stages). A planning session is to be arranged by the LECP advisory steering group.
