

# PRIVACY NOTICE Out of Hours' Emergency Call Answering Service

# 1. Purpose

In order to maintain good customer relations and ensure the Council can respond to an emergency situation on a 24/7 basis Cork City Council has engaged a 3<sup>rd</sup> party to provide an emergency out of hours call answering service.

17.00hrs to 09.00hrs daily and from 17.00hrs Friday to 09.00hrs Monday every weekend incl public holidays.

## 2. Lawful Basis

The legal basis for the collection of this data is provided for under the GDPR Article 6 (1) (c) – "Processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Controller". Article 6 (1) (d)- "Processing is necessary in order to protect the vital interests of the data subject or of another natural person" Cork City Council is the data controller.

#### 3. Personal data

In order to process your call you will need to provide us with some personal data including special category data. This will include but is not limited to your name, contact details, address, Eircode and details of the emergency and the service required.

#### 4. Information Sharing

Yor information will be shared with

- Key Answering Systems t/a Arema Connect, our 3<sup>rd</sup> party processor who will be providing the emergency out of hours call answering service on our behalf.
- Relevant sections of the Council to respond to your call.
- Other agencies such as the HSE, An Garda Síochána, Uisce Éireann, Utility companies, etc. if the emergency requires their involvement or assistance.

## How long will data be retained?

Your personal data will be retained in accordance with the National Retention Schedules for Local Authority Records.

#### 5. Your rights:

You have certain rights in relation to your personal information that is processed by us. These rights are listed below. These rights are not absolute and apply subject to certain conditions. Your rights include:

- the right to access personal data held by us about you;
- the right to require us to rectify any inaccurate personal data held by us about you;
- in certain circumstances, the right to require us to erase personal data held by us about you;

- in certain circumstances, the right to restrict our processing of personal data held by us about you;
- in certain circumstances, a right to receive personal data which you have provided to us
  in a structured, commonly used and machine readable format. You may also have the
  right to require us to transfer this personal data to another organisation, at your
  request;
- the right to object to our processing of personal data held by us about you (including for the purposes of sending marketing materials to you); and
- the right to withdraw your consent, where we are relying on it to use your personal data

Please note that to help protect your privacy, we take steps to verify your identity before granting access to personal data.
