6 SICAP

Rebecca Loughry: The Cork City Boundary Extension does not cover any extension of the SICAP Programme area due to contractual agreement prior to the boundary extension of the city. Meetings with Cork County Council are ongoing to ensure delivery of SICAP services in those areas are not interrupted. This will afford a more seamless handover when the new SICAP iteration is agreed and finalised.

Kieran O'Connell mid-year programme review to be completed by 14th June. 2 posts will be funded for SICAP research worker, closing date 30th of May.

a. Sláintecare Healthy Communities/ Healthy Ireland fund
